Trailers location: by Region, NWTEMC will keep big trailer for training

Map or spreadsheet will created of Trailer locations, Tribes

All trailers need to be delivered to tribes before August 8th, 2009, when DOH grant ends

- o Lower Elwha Klallam for Region 2
- o Nisqually Tribe, for Region 3
- Muckleshoot for Region 6 (King County)

- Spokane Tribe for Region 9
- Note: Region 5 has no member Tribes and Cowlitz does not have land to store a trailer in R4
- All equipment ordered/purchased
- CERT manuals with NWTEMC logo printed and delivered
- Break down: 5 classes*30 training units+30 books= 150 training kits/books per trailer, and more equip to be purchased
