

QUILEUTE TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2010A - 59

WHEREAS, the Quileute Indian Tribe is an Indian Tribe organized under the Indian Reorganization Act, and the Quileute Tribal Council is the duly constituted governing body of the Quileute Indian Tribe by authority of Article III of the Constitution and By-laws of the Quileute Indian Tribe approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 11, 1935;

WHEREAS, the ancestors of the present Quileute Tribe were a party to the Treaty of Olympia, signed in 1855 and reauthorized in 1856, and enjoy the rights reserved to it by that Treaty;

WHEREAS, the Quileute Tribal Council has the authority to initiate participation in established programs for the benefit and well-being of the Tribe and its employees; and

WHEREAS, the Quileute Tribal Council realizes there is an advantage for all parties by participating with training and exercising with other Tribes and organizations for the purpose of emergency management; and

WHEREAS, the Quileute Tribal Council also recognizes that exercising, individual and collective preparedness and maintaining a Contact (POC) is of the utmost importance for continued survival of the Tribe and it's Members and employees; and

WHEREAS, the Participation of the Quileute Tribe Northwest Tribal Emergency Management Council (NWTEMC) will facilitate the above; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Quileute Tribal Council hereby authorizes the designated representative(s) of the Emergency Management Team to initiate and sustain participation in the NWTEMC, at no cost to the Tribe, other than maintaining a POC.
